Seduva Gymnasium in Lithuania (coordinator)

Seduva Gymnasium is situated in small green town Seduva with the population of 3500. The gymnasium dates back from 1941 and is located in three seperate buildings in a large green territory: primary school, gymnasium, school with the dormitory for children with special needs. 568 students aged from 7 to 19 learn here. They learn science, languages (Lithuanian, English, Russian, French), history, geography, technology, art, sports, ethics or religion. Students can attend various clubs after school such as modern and folk dances, orchestra, karate, art, choir, woodcraft, basketball, tennis, football. They are taught by 65 teachers. You can do sports in a new modern stadium. Many events are organised at school. The teachers and students are actively involved in national and international projects (since 2000). The town and school have got strong cultural traditions.
